

# Can I schedule an appointment at Walgreens to receive the COVID-19 vaccine?

Walgreens will provide easy and convenient scheduling options for in-store appointments including online or through the Walgreens app. To schedule, visit **Walgreens.com/ ScheduleVaccine**. You can also sign up for vaccine availability updates in your area via email by visiting **Walgreens.com/VaccineUpdates**.

#### How many shots of COVID-19 vaccine are required?

Both the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines require two shots to be as effective as possible. The Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine requires just one shot.

## How will Walgreens coordinate vaccines with two doses?

For vaccines that require two shots, Walgreens schedules both appointments at the same time as part of the scheduling experience.

#### When are people considered fully vaccinated?

Two weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose series, or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine. Fully vaccinated people should keep wearing a mask and social distancing in public places.

#### Are COVID-19 vaccines safe?

Vaccines have played an important role in protecting the health and safety of communities and nations throughout history. As a critical resource for care in our communities, Walgreens will remain focused on providing safe and convenient access to COVID-19 vaccines.
