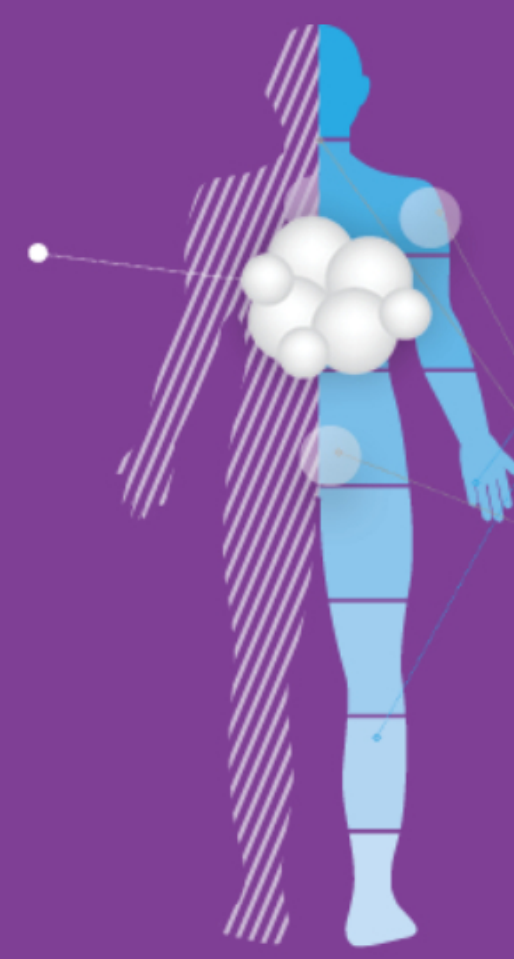


ABOUT HODGKIN LYMPHOMA

HODGKIN LYMPHOMA (HL)

Hodgkin lymphoma is a cancer that originates in **white blood cells called lymphocytes**, which are part of the body's immune system.¹



Hodgkin lymphoma can **start almost anywhere**.¹

The most common symptom of HL is an **enlarged lymph node, or lump in the neck, under the arm or in the groin**.²

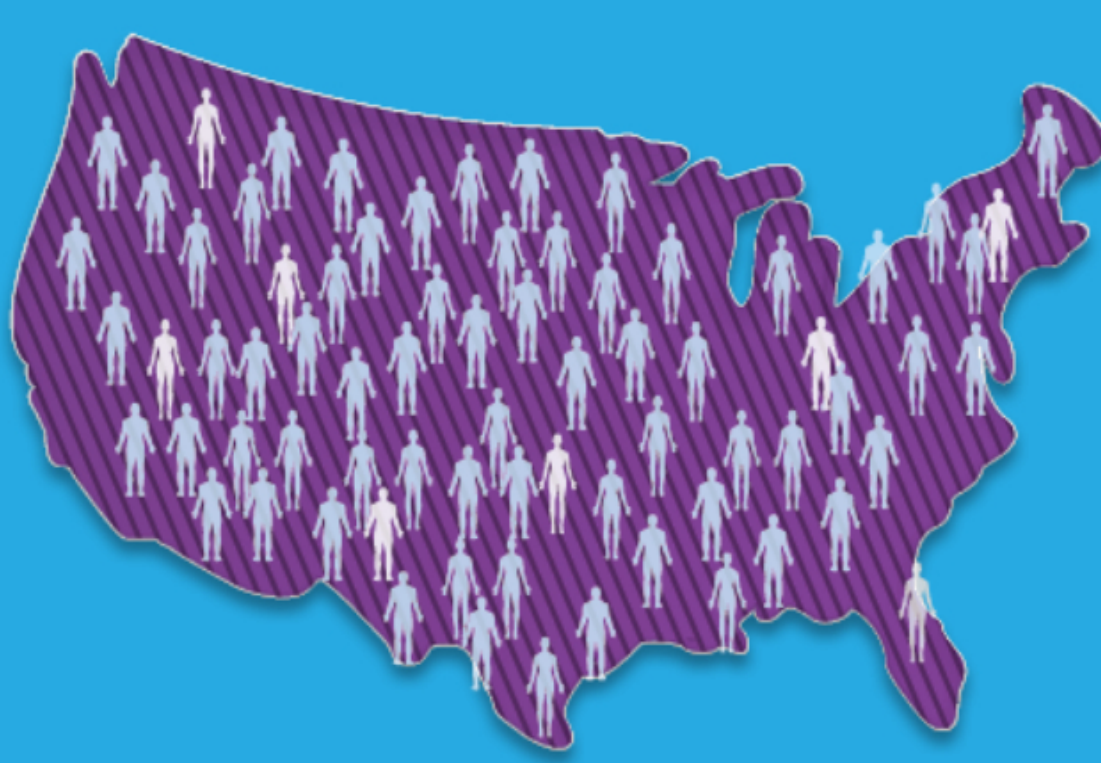
(Hodgkin lymphoma is slightly more common in males than females)

AGE

In fact, Hodgkin lymphoma is most common in early adulthood (a person's 20s), and the risk rises again in late adulthood (after age 55)³

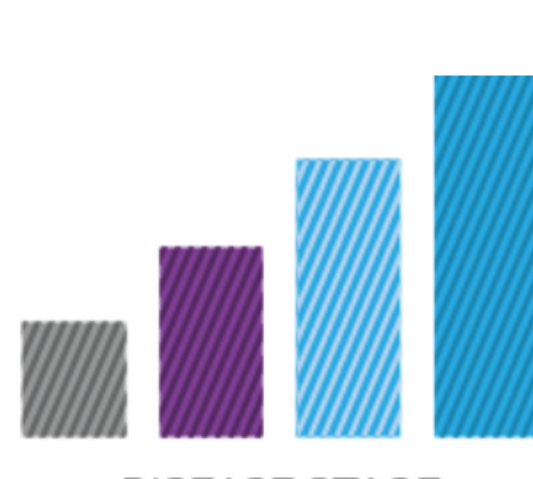
According to the American Cancer Society, approximately

8,480 CASES OF HODGKIN

LYMPHOMA WILL BE DIAGNOSED

in the United States during 2020 and about 970 will die from the disease.⁴

Hodgkin lymphoma TREATMENT



DISEASE STAGE

The stages of Hodgkin lymphoma tell you about the number and places in the body that are affected and helps your doctor to decide what treatment you need. **Early-stage disease is defined as Stage 1 or 2**.⁵

Advanced-stage disease is typically defined as Stage 3 or 4.⁵



Stages 1-4 of Hodgkin lymphoma are generally treated with **chemotherapy or combination regimens**.⁶

Advanced-stage Hodgkin lymphoma patients have **poorer outcomes** compared with early-stage Hodgkin lymphoma patients when **treated with chemotherapy**.⁷

Hodgkin lymphoma has an overall 5-year survival rate of 86.6%⁸
The percentage of people who live at least 5 years after being diagnosed with HL, by stage:⁸



Stage 1/2

Hodgkin lymphoma has a 5-year survival rate of approximately **90%**



Stage 3

Hodgkin lymphoma has a 5-year survival rate of **83%**



Stage 4

Hodgkin lymphoma has a 5-year survival rate of **73%**



For many people with Hodgkin lymphoma, treatment can cure the lymphoma, while others will see their Hodgkin lymphoma come back.⁹



Some chemotherapy drugs can have long-lasting side effects, some of which might not occur until months or years after treatment has ended, such as lung damage, secondary cancers, loss of fertility and heart disease.^{10,11}

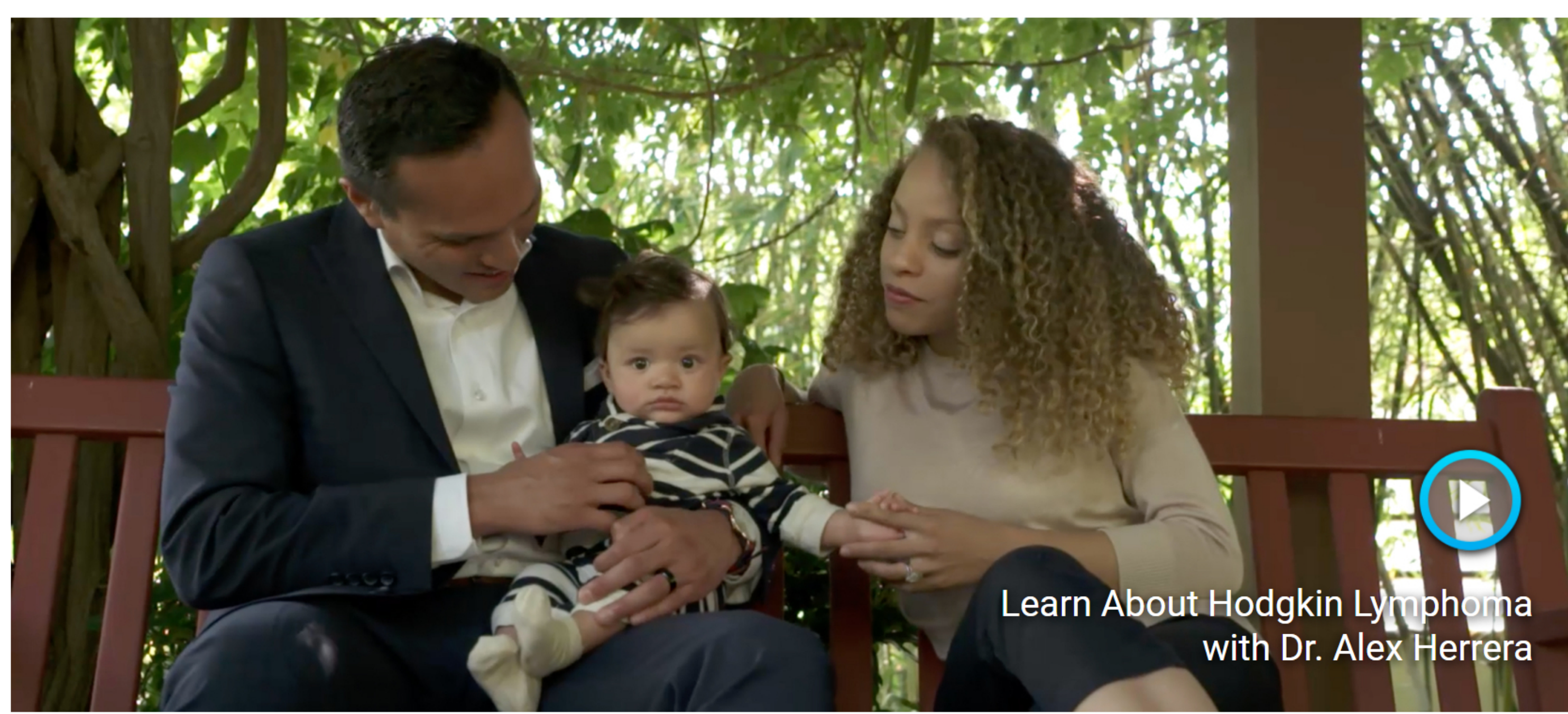
